Activity: Observing and Anticipating

- Have students stand in a large circle.
- Start the activity by sending a handclap around the circle. One student claps their hands, and the next student must clap in response as quickly as they can, continuing around the circle.
- Gradually increase the complexity by varying the rhythm or introducing a pattern that students must follow (e.g. two fast claps, followed by one slow clap).
- After the activity, discuss the importance of observering and anticipating in both personal interactions and professional settings, such as responding to pateint cues in healthcare.
