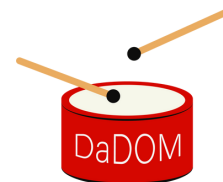


Lesson 6 - Tips & Activities

Tips:

- Begin your lesson by clearly defining the roles of healthcare professionals and music therapists. Highlight the specialized training that music therapists undergo and the specific contributions they make to patient care. Ensure that students understand that while they may incorporate some aspects of music into their interactions with patients, the therapeutic use of music to achieve specific psychological, social, and physical goals is the domain of trained music therapists.
- Encourage students to think of healthcare as a team effort, where each member, including music therapists and musicians, play a crucial role. Discuss case studies that showcase successful uses of simple daily musical interventions (you can find the case studies in the care organisation toolkit). Encourage students to ask questions about each professional's role and how they can effectively communicate and collaborate to enhance patient outcomes.



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
